A BYLAW TO ADOPT THE FINANCIAL PLAN FOR JUMBO GLACIER MOUNTAIN RESORT MUNICIPALITY FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 19, 2013 TO DECEMBER 31, 2013

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as the "JUMBO GLACIER FINANCIAL PLAN BYLAW NO. 0002, 2013".
- 2. Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of the Bylaw shall be the Financial Plan of Jumbo Glacier Mountain Resort Municipality for the period of February 19, 2013 to December 31, 2013
- 3. Schedule 'B' attached hereto and forming part of the Bylaw shall be the Financial Objectives and Policies of Jumbo Glacier Mountain Resort Municipality for the period of February 19, 2013 to December 31, 2013.
